#### Leading to Reading at the Agincourt Library

#### What is Leading to Reading?

This **free** service helps children <u>who are having</u> <u>difficulty</u> with their reading or writing. It's for children who are in grades 1 to 6 as of last September. Children must speak and understand English to participate in this service.

#### What happens?

A volunteer meets your child at the library for a maximum of one hour per week at a regularly scheduled time. Children receive help and encouragement with their reading and writing and also play literacy based games and activities. Fun, engaging and interactive sessions are an important part of your child's learning.

#### When does it occur?

Sessions run continuously throughout the year with several holiday breaks. The service days and times depend on the local library.

#### Who are the volunteers?

The volunteers may be high school students, university students, adults, or seniors. Toronto Public Library screens volunteers and provides training.

#### How do I join?

Please complete and return this form to the library. You may also email the completed application to the branch contact below. Take the Teacher Assessment page and have your child's teacher fill it in and return it to you. Or have the teacher email it to you.

**Please Note**: Your application will be considered only if the Teacher Assessment page is completed. If you are not able to get this form completed, please contact the service staff, their contact information is at the bottom of this sheet. Your application will be held for six months, after which you will need to reapply if you are still interested in this service.

#### A little more about the Leading to Reading Service...

Leading to Reading is not a formal tutoring service but we try to improve children's reading and writing skills. We also try to build children's interest and confidence in reading, writing and learning. Enrollment is based on student and volunteer availability, service space, and child needs, not by application date.

To help as many children as possible, these registration conditions apply. You and your child must:

- $\sqrt{}$  Attend every session (choose a time when there will be no other activities)
- $\sqrt{}$  Arrive and pick up on time (Please note that we do not supervise your child before or after sessions)
- $\sqrt{}$  Let your Leading to Reading volunteer know if your child cannot attend, **before** the session starts
- $\sqrt{}$  Participation is limited to one library branch
- $\sqrt{}$  Have a library card (it's free) and borrow books to read at home
