SUMMARY

At its April 30, 2012 meeting, the Toronto Public Library Board requested the Toronto Public Library “Open Hours Vision”. In January 2006, the Open Hours Vision outlined in *The Best Thing a Library Can Be Is Open: Update on Branch Open Hours* report was adopted by the Library Board. In June 2006 an implementation plan was approved. Both of these reports are attached, along with selected accompanying tables and maps. A presentation on the Open Hours Vision is also included.

Since approval of the plan in 2006, 155.5 open hours per week were added in 2007 through the introduction of standard scheduling efficiencies and 165.5 hours per week were added from 2008 to 2011 through self service check out efficiencies.
