The Toronto Public Library Board recognizes the importance of reading in the lives of all Canadians and in particular, the residents of Toronto. To that end, the Library has built a collection designed to meet the needs of these residents and, as outlined in the Library's Mission Statement, promotes universal access to a broad range of human knowledge, experience, information and ideas.

In the Library's Strategic Plan 2012 – 2015 under the first Priority Area of *Grow a City of Readers* the Library is committed to *fostering literacy and a love of reading as a first priority; supporting readers of all ages in improving print literacy skills and in discovering great stories and books*.
