

Outlined below is Section 36 of the Toronto Public Library Board's Procedural By-law before the proposed amendment. In the proposed amendment, Section 36.1.2 has been revised and a new section 2 has been added.

Meetings

36	Motion to Reconsider	.1	After the result of the vote is announced, any Member who voted with the majority may move a motion to reconsider:
		.1	at the same meeting; or
		.2	may give notice of a motion to reconsider the matter at any subsequent meeting in the following twelve-month period.
			No discussion of the matter will be allowed until the motion to reconsider has carried.
		.2	No matter will be reconsidered more than once in a twelve-month period.
