CONFIDENTIAL RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Librarian recommends that the Toronto Public Library Board:

1. Establish a Selection Committee to recruit and select a new City Librarian;
2. Establish the following membership for the Selection Committee:
 - Library Board Chair;
 - Library Board Vice-Chair;
 - one Library Board member who is a Councillor;
 - one citizen member of the Library Board;
 - one external member from the library community;
 - the Director, Human Resources (to provide technical assistance).
3. Authorize the Chair to take the names of volunteers and nominations for the citizen and councillor members of the Selection Committee, and if necessary conduct a vote to determine those members of the Committee; and
4. Authorize staff to hire an external search firm to assist with the recruitment process and to make expenditures appropriate with the recruitment and selection of a new City Librarian.
