Subject: **Toronto Public Library Foundation Assessment of 2006/2007 Fundraising Priorities**

Purpose:

To provide the Toronto Public Library Foundation's response to the Toronto Public Library's list of 2006/2007 fundraising priorities.

Funding Implications and Impact Statement:

The Toronto Public Library Foundation's contributions to the Library's programs and services supplement the Library's approved capital and operating budgets. The Toronto Public Library Foundation anticipates being able to raise approximately \$800,000 towards the identified priority projects.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Toronto Public Library Board receive the *Toronto Public Library Foundation Assessment of 2006/2007 Fundraising Priorities* report for information.
