**Topic:** Report Request – Achieving a Paperless Board through Technology

### Background:

The Toronto Public Library as one of the largest per capita users has become a leader in many different areas. As we move into the 21st century there is a huge demand for our public library system to be on the leading edge when it comes to technology. We offer basic computers, 3D printing, technology hubs, and classes open to the public on how to make the most of the services we offer.

The Toronto Public Library Board members should be doing more in this area to lead by example which includes learning about and using existing and new technology to help our organization meet its mandate. Library staff should be asked to explore options for achieving a paperless Board through technology. One idea would be to use tablets for the distribution of the Board agenda package.

### Recommendation:
