

Current Section 25 – In Camera Meetings
Toronto Public Library Board Procedural By-law

- 25 In Camera meetings**
- .1 At each meeting, the Board will consider whether disclosure of each item on its agenda proposed to be considered in Camera would:
 - .1 result in the disclosure of intimate financial and personal matters; and
 - .2 outweigh the desirability of protecting against public disclosure; or
 - .3 result in disclosure of information that is subject to solicitor-client privilege;and will determine whether or not to consider each such item In Camera.
 - .2 The Board will move In Camera by resolution. The resolution must indicate the general reason(s) for moving In Camera.
 - .3 Only those matters agreed to in public for consideration In Camera may be discussed.
 4. No person will disclose any deliberations or decisions at an In Camera meeting unless the decision is made public by Board resolution.
