Dear Ms Bryant:

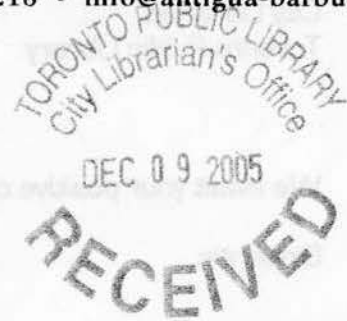
I am writing on behalf of the members of the CARICOM Consular Corps and in support of naming the Black and Caribbean Heritage Collection at the Parkdale Library after its founder, Dr. Rita Cox, former Head of the Parkdale Branch Library.

This collection has been an integral part of the Parkdale inter-cultural community since 1972 and over the thirty-three years of its existence has been responsible for raising the awareness of Caribbean literature within the wider literary community and for making the Parkdale Library a "place to go - a must see".
