

**Toronto Public Library
2003 Operating Budget
Options for Re-instatement of Library Hours on Summer Friday Evenings**

The additional \$0.050 million does not allow reinstatement of summer Friday evening hours at all branches. The original plan saw all branches closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday night during July and August. This affected 80 branches in total and represented a loss of 136 hours weekly. The following options have been identified for partial reinstatement of the Friday summer evening closures.

Option 1

Option 1 restores hours to all branches that lost either half hour (5:30 p.m. closing) or one hour (6 p.m. closing). It also restores hours to Agincourt district branch.

Rationale:

- Reinstates a total of 48.5 hours weekly
- Reinstates hours at the maximum number of branches (53 branches)
- Fewer changes required and more easily communicated to the public

Rationale:

- Reinstates a total of 24.5 hours weekly
- Reinstates hours at larger facilities with a wider range of services and higher activity levels
