Youth	Youth aged 13-25 – this category includes marginalized or at-risk youth. Youth who are young parents, living in shelters, early school leavers, or those living in low income families	Literacy School support Volunteer opportunities Employment
Newcomers/Immigrants/ Cultural Groups	Newcomers to Canada - addresses newcomers who are youth, adults, seniors Cultural Groups Addresses the needs of Toronto residents to maintain ties with their cultures of origin including aboriginals	Settlement information Language acquisition School preparation/support Employment Access to materials/ program related cultures and language of origin
Older Adults and Seniors	Older adults and seniors address the needs of adults planning for retirement, retired active adults, the elderly and the frail elderly living in care facilities, and their caregivers	Specialized collections Programs Computer Training Targeted services (Home Library Service)
