Background:

Toronto City Council adopted a *Fraud and Other Similar Irregularities Policy* at its regular meeting held on April 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27, 2001 and its special meeting held on April 30, May 1 and 2, 2001 (Attachment 2).

Comments:

A policy consistent with the City's policy is provided to the Board for approval. The City Auditor will conduct and coordinate any investigations pursuant to this policy. The policy has been reviewed with City staff to ensure that it can be implemented in an effective manner.

Conclusion:

This policy forms part of the Library's ongoing efforts to harmonize the different policies of the former library systems in accordance with the City's approval of policies.
