SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to provide the Toronto Public Library Foundation's response to the Toronto Public Library's list of 2010/2011 fundraising priorities.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The Foundation's contributions to the Library's programs and services supplement the Library's approved capital and operating budgets. The Foundation anticipates being able to raise approximately \$2,200,000 towards the identified priority projects in 2010.

The Director, Finance & Treasurer has reviewed this financial impact statement and is in agreement with it.

DECISION HISTORY

The Board's approved list of fundraising initiatives was submitted to the Foundation for their consideration and response on the funding potential of the identified projects.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

At the March 22, 2010 meeting of the Toronto Public Library Board, it was:
