Hello,

I wish to bring my concerns to the library board. I came across a poster about a meeting that will take place at the Lillian H. Smith branch this Sunday, June 4, 2023. The meeting is titled "The War in Ukraine and How to Stop It", and the subtitle is "The historical and political origins of the US-NATO war against Russia". I must express my shock and disappointment in seeing that the library I love and support would allow itself to be used to legitimize and amplify Russian propaganda.

I have seen an email response to another reader from the Manager of Service Development - Venue & Community, Ms. Beth Kaweck. In her response, Ms. Kaweck states that the event is not presented by the Toronto Public Library (TPL), but a third-party room rental booking. Ms. Kaweck further states that TPL will only allow room rental bookings that do not violate your Community and Event Space Rental policy.

In this instance, I do not think that TPL has done sufficient due diligence to prevent and indeed stop its venues and facilities from being abused by propagandists. Surely your Community and Event Space Rental policy would not permit propaganda to be peddled within your walls. I doubt that if someone were to book the same room to host an event to praise the Third Reich, you would have considered that as not in violation of your policy. To allow this event to take place on your property is to condone all the atrocities that Russia has committed in Ukraine, from rape to kidnapping to genocide, to name a few.

Ms. Kaweck continues to state that as a publically funded government institution, TPL must offer services equitably to everyone within the limits of the law, which extends to third-party room bookings, including those that may involve controversial or unpopular content and speakers.

The Canadian government officially considers Russia as the invading country and has imposed multiple economic sanctions since February 2022. To quote a previous new release from our federal government, "Canada reiterates its strong condemnation of the Russian Federation's war crimes in Ukraine, which include rape, torture and the indiscriminate murder of civilians". To offer equitable services to those who spread Russian propaganda while Russia is actively violating international law is not true equity. It is blindness. It is insensitivity. It is a complete disregard for what's right and what's wrong. It is certainly not what the public would expect or accept from a government institution.

I urge you to listen to the public, reconsider your policy, do the right thing, and cancel this disgraceful event.

Dear Toronto Public Library staff, Library Board Members
and Ontario public servants,

This Sunday, June 4, the International Youth and Students section of the Socialist Equality Party is scheduled to hold an antiwar meeting at the Toronto Public Library (Lillian H. Smith Branch). The meeting has come under attack by Conservative Party Labour Minister Monte McNautghton, who has spread the lie that the IYSSE defends the Russian invasion of Ukraine. According to the SEP's newspaper, the *World Socialist Web Site*, the Ukrainian Canadian Congress has threatened violence against one of the scheduled speakers, Keith Jones.

Along with Canadian magazines like *Canadian Dimension* and activist journalists like Dimitri Lascaris, the *WSWS* is one of the few news sources to have consistently and accurately reported on the economic and foreign policy strategies that have led to the conflict in Ukraine, which has now killed 400,000 soldiers and displaced 8 million Ukrainians. This conflict threatens a direct NATO war with Russia and US generals have said that war with China is expected by 2025.

Thank you for your defence of the right of the IYSSE to present its antiwar arguments to the public, a necessary corrective to the reckless decisions of every major political party in Canada to support the Great Power Conflict foreign policy strategy of the USA, a process that is taking global neoliberal capitalism in the direction of global fascism. Every fascism is a failed revolution.
