Correspondence, autographs collected by Miss Cara Hartwell of Toronto. Includes letters from many famous personalities in the arts world, actors, playwrights, authors, opera singers, dancers and film directors. Also includes photographs, many autographed, of music personalities, a series of autograph books, and a collection of autographed cards. Among the letters are letters from W. Somerset Maugham from 1935 to 1955, several mentioning his tastes in literature and commenting on some of his own books and plans for books. There is also a series of letters from dancer Ted Shawn relating interesting anecdotes about his experiences with motion pictures and with astrology. Especially informative is correspondence from other film fans describing visits to retired movie stars and giving biographical details and "what ever happened to" information on stars of the silent film era.

Over the years, Miss Hartwell has made many generous gifts to the Theatre Department. Her donation of photographs and film stills formed the basis of the department's photograph collection. The photos of actors and dancers from this most recent gift have been interfiled with this larger collection. Her gifts of books, recordings and such film fan periodicals as *Photoplay* have also been added to the general collection.

Benham, Florence, wife of Leland Benham (1905-1976), American actor. ALS Oct. 18, 1976 [Boynton Beach, FL]. To John Thayer re: his inquiry concerning Harry Benham (1883-1969), the silent film leading man. Gives biographical data on Harry, and on his son Leland, her late husband.

Her opera production was a "huge success" despite many difficulties. Was interested to hear of Evelyn Pasen; would be glad to listen to her and give advice. (+ envelope)

Donalda, Pauline (1882-1970), Canadian soprano. ALS Aug. 10, 1963 [Montreal]. Thanks for letter; comments on CH's gift of opera and ballet records and film stills to Toronto Central Library. Montreal Festivals currently presenting *Werther* with Richard Verran in the title role and one of her pupils as Charlotte. (+ envelope)

Donalda, Pauline (1882-1970), Canadian soprano. ALS Jan. 3, 1964 [Montreal]. Christmas card. Couldn't reciprocate seasons greetings as CH had not written address on her card; found an old letter mentioning a visit to Montreal for the International Festival. Donalda was on TV for opening of Place des Arts; did CH see her? Thinks her gift to library was wonderful. Donalda gave her own scores to McGill. (+ envelope) (see also Wilson, Arthur A.)

Ferrar, Geraldine (1882-1967), American opera singer and actress. ALS Mar. 28, 1965 [Ridgefield, CT]. Thanks CH for her note. Mentions recent eighty-third anniversary celebration. (+ envelope)

Fealy, Maude (Mrs. Louis F Sherwin) (1883-1971), American actress. ALS Oct. 29, 1953 [Sun Valley, CA]. Encloses a card detailing her current activities (brief bio and programs available for engagement) in addition to teaching. Has bought a house near Hollywood where she lives with her aged mother. Speaks of meeting radio actor Hal "Gildersleeve" Peary at a bank opening, visiting Mignon Anderson in Burbank and meeting Maxine Elliott Dodge playing in *The Curious Savage*.

Flack, Frank, film fan. TLS Nov. 16, 1976 [Los Angeles] to JT. Describes visit to Corinne Griffith. Thanks JT for bios on George Cleveland and Lynn Fontanne, and for addresses for several stars, whom he plans to write. Regrets he can't supply dates for Milton Parsons or Willard Robinson. Suggests JT write to Adrienne Barbeau and gives agent's address.

Flack, Frank, film fan. TLS Jun. 5, 1978 to JT. Describes visit to Bessie Learn Robbins, a silent film star who gave him news of several other actors. Received a photo from Celeste Holm and gives details and address so JT might do the same.

Flack, Frank, film fan. TLS Dec. 9, 1978 to JT. Visited Bessie Learn Robbins who'd just celebrated her 90th birthday. Also heard from Mignon Anderson and Maxine Elliott, who were both concerned about JT's health.

Flagstad, Kirsten (1895-1962), Norwegian soprano. Apr. 4, 1952 [Manhattan, Kansas]. Fragment of letter (from CH?) with note from Flagstad on reverse regretting she has no photo of Alceste that she approves of. Signed KF. (+ envelope + address handwritten in KF's hand)

Fremstad, Olive (1871-1951), Swedish/American soprano. ALS Feb. 7, 1943. Asks CH if she could send a copy of photo of OF as Venus. Gives a source for Mishkin photos, but thinks the Venus is from Annie Dupont, and the plates were destroyed long ago by fire.

Fremstad, Olive (1871-1951), Swedish/American soprano. ALS Apr. 6, 1943. Thanks CH for photos including the young Carmen; asks where she gets her pictures. Has returned autographed photos. (+ envelope)

Garden, Mary (1874-1967), Scottish soprano. ALS Mar. 14, 1942 [Aberdeen]. Thanks CH for her letter. Glad to hear from Canada, which has given so much aid in the war. While she is glad CH likes her records, says she dislikes recording. Also being photographed. Is staying with her mother in Aberdeen for duration of war, and writing her memoirs. (+ envelope, no stamp)

Garden, Mary (1874-1967), Scottish soprano. ALS Jun. 1, 1942 [Aberdeen]. Encloses signed photos from the opera *Aphrodite*. (+ envelope, no stamp)

Gay, Clive, English actor. ALS Dec. 7, 1950 [London]. Left a previous letter in a library book so is repeating the same news. Encloses a photo of Betty Balfour; doesn't know her address or married name. Asks for picture of Pauline Frederick, an actress he has a scrapbook on. Has been writing Gloria Swanson, with no reply. Mentions his own work on the stage – in rehearsal for a pantomime, and current whereabouts of Violet Hopson. (+ envelope, no stamp)

Gilmour, Clyde (1912-), Canadian critic & broadcaster. ALS Dec. 15, 1982 [Toronto]. Thanks for CH's letter. Regrets he's unable to find info on a Japanese artist's appearance in Toronto, or recent news of tenor Pierre Duval.

Gish, Lillian (1896-), American silent film and stage actress. TLS Nov. 22, 1953 [New York, NY]. Thanks for CH's letter and interest in her career. (+ envelope)

Gish, Lillian (1896-), American silent film and stage actress. TLS Feb. 27, 1976. Mentions new film *Gemini*, and the author Joseph Hergesheimer. Encloses signed photos of herself and Dorothy Gish.

Glover, Julian (1935-), English actor. TLS Feb. 23, 1967 [London]. Apologizes for typing and for poor photo enclosed. Thanks CH for letter and clipping about recent film *I Was Happy Here*. Discusses problems with distribution. Lists some of his recent stage, TV and film work including his roles in *Girl with Green Eyes*, *Tom Jones*, *Theatre of Death* with Christopher Lee and upcoming role in a sci-fi film. "Once again playing an absolute swine!" [he often plays villains] (+ envelope, no stamp)

Gordon, Kitty (Mrs. Ralph Ranlet) (1878-1974), English actress. Dec. 6, 1973 [Ross Nursing Home, Brentwood, NY]. (Letter written for Kitty, then 95, but with her signature.) Thanks CH for her letter. Has no photos at present, but will send one when available. Asks that CH write again soon. (+ envelope, no stamp).

Gueden, Hilde (1917-), Austrian soprano. Envelope Feb. 18, 1952 [New York, NY]. (While singing with Met.) Holograph signature and return address. No letter.
