

Thomas Turvey and Thomas Hilton Turvey Collection

Very little information is known about Thomas Turvey and Thomas Hilton-Turvey. After serving as organist for several British churches, Thomas Turvey came to Toronto around 1875 to become organist at the West Methodist Metropolitan Church. He is represented in this unit by a manuscript copy of a mass and by his published work "Te deum laudamus". Thomas Hilton-Turvey (his son?) was born in Birkenhead, England in 1863, studied at the University of Pennsylvania and taught in Philadelphia. He was predominantly a songwriter, and published over thirty compositions.
