Toronto Public Library's Chinese Canadian Archive (CCA) is a community-built archive celebrating and highlighting the history and experiences of Chinese Canadians in the Greater Toronto Area. With support from the [Digital Museums Canada investment program](#), TPL has embarked on a project to create a digital exhibit to further share and explore this heritage, featuring stories and records from the CCA.







Which Toronto Public Library location do you use the most?




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What is your age range?







Which generation of Chinese Canadian do you identify as? If between different generations, please round up numerically.







Which of the following themes are the most important for you to see reflected in the digital exhibit? Select up to three [3].












