

## Toronto Public Library Chinese Canadian Archive Digital Exhibit Community Survey Results

Toronto Public Library's Chinese Canadian Archive (CCA) is a community-built archive celebrating and highlighting the history and experiences of Chinese Canadians in the Greater Toronto Area. With support from the [Digital Museums Canada investment program](#), TPL has embarked on a project to create a digital exhibit to further share and explore this heritage, featuring stories and records from the CCA.

To seek guidance from the community for the development of the archive and the digital exhibit, the project team conducted an online survey from 4<sup>th</sup> October to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2023.

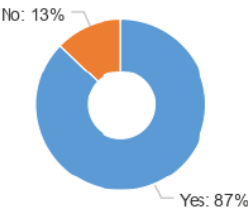

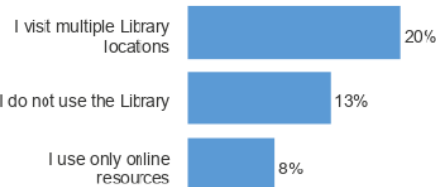

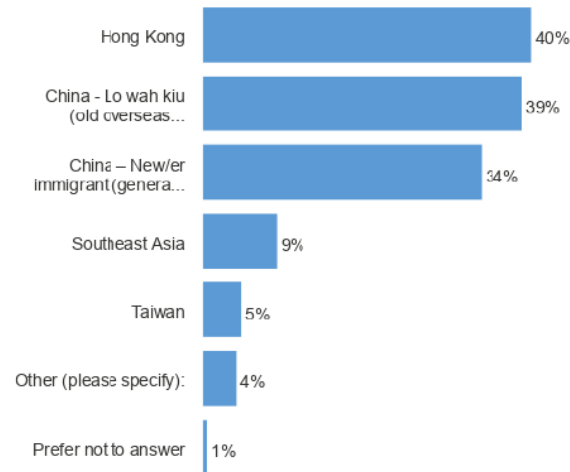

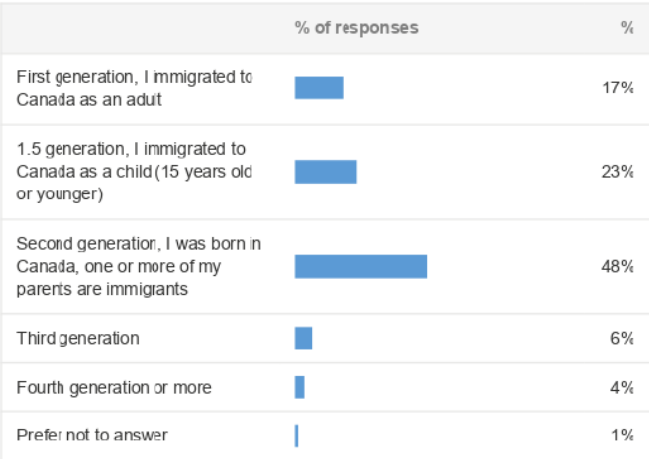

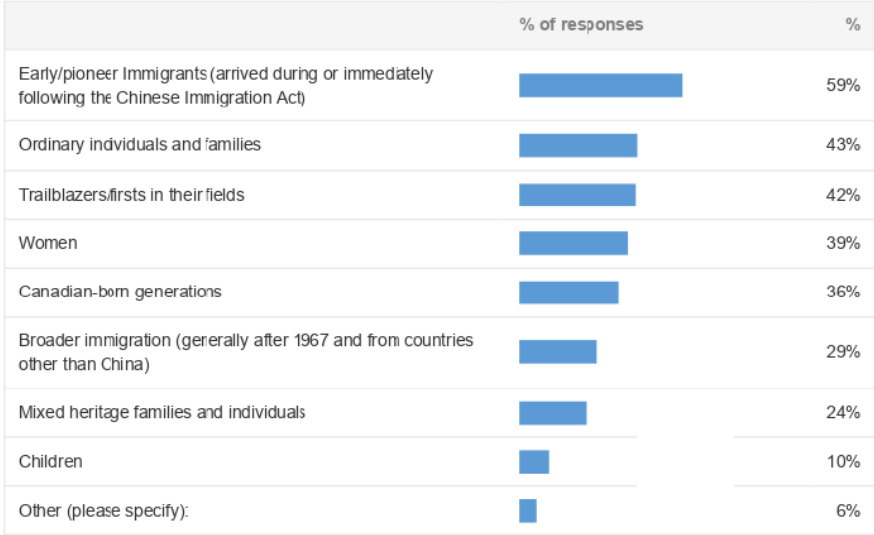

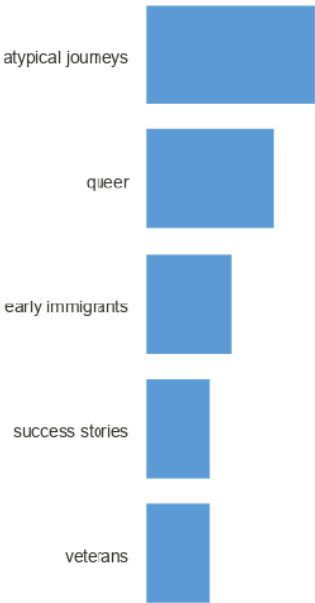
Digital exhibit design and development

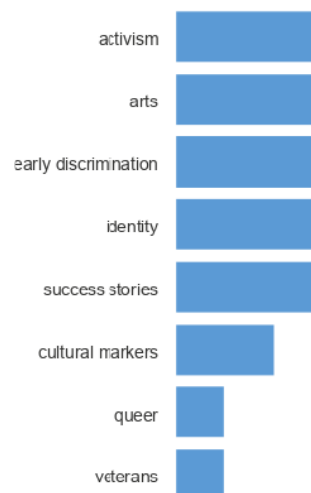

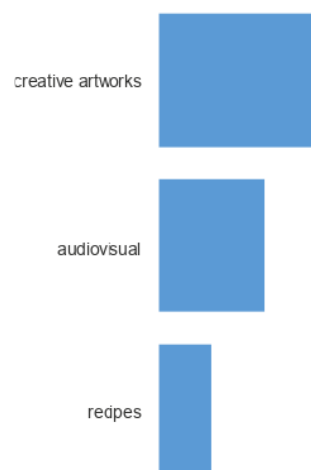

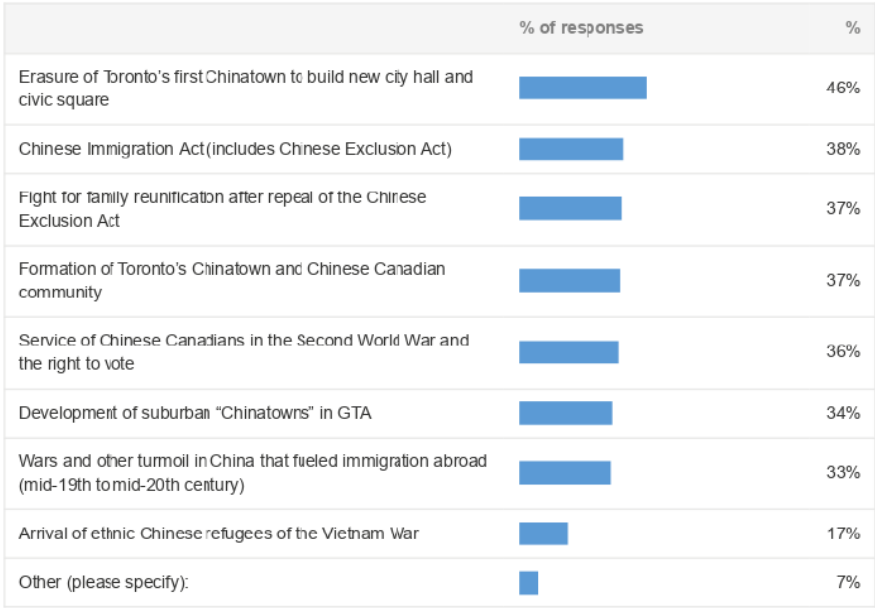

What parts of Chinese Canadian history do you feel are the most unknown among community members and/or the public and need more attention? Select up to three [3].



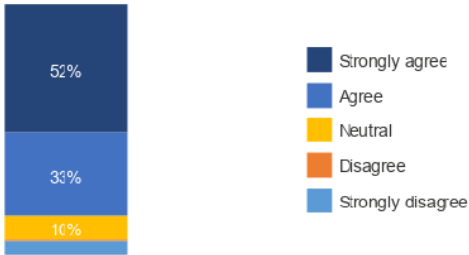

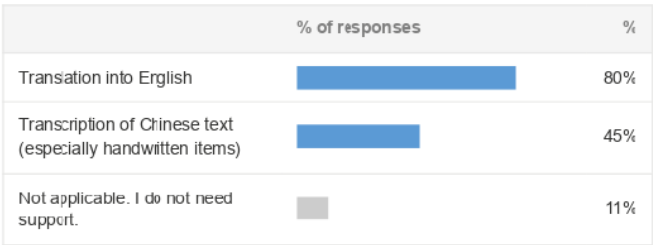

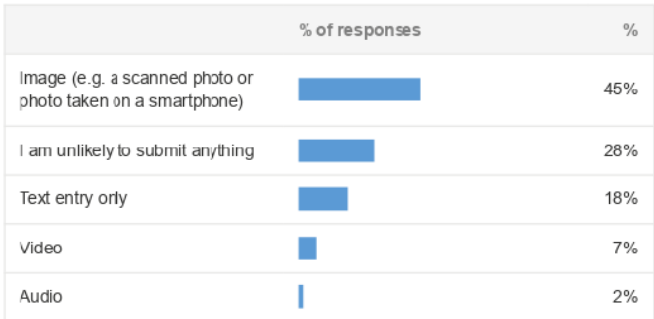

What type(s) of support do you need to understand and appreciate Chinese-language items included in the digital exhibit? Select all that apply.



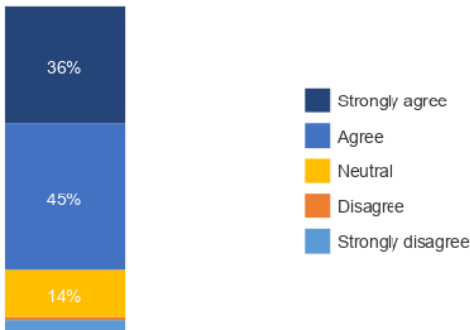
